Please keep in mind that Opening Weekend is a very busy weekend at our pool and there may be times when you have to wait to enter the pool facility. Guest passes may not be used during Opening Weekend (May 25-27).

NOTICE: Historically, the pool reaches its maximum bather load capacity most of the opening weekend. Due to this heavy volume, Lap Lanes will NOT BE

AVAILABLE until Tuesday May 28.

FEES

MAINTENANCE FEE:

The annual Maintenance Fee is \$425.00. Fees must have been postmarked no later than April 15, 2019. Any fees dropped in our mailbox, post-marked or received electronically after April 15th will be assessed a late fee. (see below).

(There is an additional \$15 credit card fee to pay online, to cover the processing fee.)

LATE FEES: Payments received after the April 15th deadline will incur a late fee:

Total due after April 15: \$450.00 (check) / \$465.00 (online)
Total due on or after June 1: \$500.00 (check) / \$515.00 (online)
Total due on or after September 1: \$525.00 (check) / \$540.00 (online)
Total due on or after December 1: \$550.00 (check) / \$565.00 (online)

Any membership with an **OUTSTANDING BALANCE** is prohibited from using the pool until the balance is **paid in full.** Membership invoices, newsletters and reminders are emailed using the email address <u>supplied by the</u> <u>member</u>; therefore, failure to receive notices due to spam blocking software or closed email accounts does not excuse the obligation to pay – <u>late fees will not be waived in these instances</u>.

ADMINISTRATIVE FEES: The pool assesses the following administrative fees:

Membership Sale: \$75.00
Membership Rental: \$100.00
Returned Checks: \$35.00

FEES OWED TO THE POOL: A member who is **two (2) years** in arrears in payment of their annual maintenance fees shall be given due notice and an opportunity to pay arrearages plus any overdue payment penalties. Failure to make these payments **on or before September 20 of the second season** shall result in their membership reverting to the Club **without payment or compensation**. (Bylaws, Article V, Section 6)

PRIVATE PARTIES

Good news! There is no longer a fee to reserve the picnic area in the southeast corner of the pool (the four picnic tables under the blue umbrellas in the grassy area next to the sand area). This means that your party will take place in a more private area.

All private parties will now take place in this area.

The area **must still be reserved**; specific reservation times have been established to avoid any confusion or conflicts. These are:

```
11:30 am - 2:30 pm
2:30 pm - 5:30 pm
5:30 pm - 8:30 pm
```

A reserved notice will be placed on the picnic tables the day of your event. Other members may use this area up until your reserved time. You may continue to use the area after your time expires if no one else is waiting (please ask at the front desk at the start of your event). Sign up using the Party Book at the front desk of the pool.

- All parties must be reserved with the Pool Manager or Assistant Manager a week in advance so that we can ensure adequate lifeguards and staffing. A party form may be obtained at the front desk.
- The guest list may not exceed 25 non-members.
- A guest list containing the names of all party guests must be submitted to the Manager/Assistant
 Manager prior to the party. Please indicate if your guests are members or non-members. This helps
 the guards in collecting guest fees.
- Payment for all guests is expected either prior to the party or on the day of the event. If you are using the "5 for \$20" guest passes, they must be purchased prior to the party.
- Absolutely NO ALCOHOL.
- All guests are expected to follow all Pool Rules.
- The Pool is not responsible for inclement weather cancellations. Make-up dates are not guaranteed.
- Party hosts are responsible for their guests' behavior. They are also responsible for cleaning up after their event; please leave the space in the same condition you found it. Failure to clean after your event may result in a cleaning fee.
- For the complete list of Private Party Rules, log onto our website www.greenbriar.org, or pick up a form at the front desk once the season starts.
- The Pool has two gas grills which are available for member use. If you would like to reserve one of the grills for your party, you may do so when you reserve your party date. Clean-up of the grill is your responsibility; failure to clean the grill may result in a cleaning fee.

SPEAKING OF THE RULES...

Due to numerous requests, the Board has clarified some of the pool rules.

STROLLER PARKING

All strollers must be parked in designated areas. Strollers may not be parked on the main pool deck for safety reasons.

SWIM SAFE TEST

- Child must be able to swim 25 meters (1 length of the pool).
- Tread water for 60 seconds
- Test must be passed annually until age 13

AGE

- Age referred to in these rules is the age attained by Memorial Day of the current year and is determined by records on file (no changes will be made by the gate attendant.)
- Adults are defined as persons being eighteen (18) years of age or older.

BREAKS

- The pool will be closed for (15) minutes beginning the last quarter of the hour for adult/family swim. Swimmers must be 18 years or older, except as noted below.
- Parents and guardians may bring up to two children under 10 years old into the pool during this time.
 They must remain in the wings of the pool and not interfere with adult activity and relaxation. U.S. Coast
 Guard approved flotation devices, life jackets, and kick boards may be used.

LAP LANES

Lap lanes are available from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM, every day (except Late Nights and Opening/Closing Weekends)

Greenbriar is a **member of the Northern Virginia Swimming League (NVSL)**, composed of teams from over 100 area pools distributed amongst 17 Divisions. This year Greenbriar competes in Division 6. SWIM LESSONS

Greenbriar Lifeguards will be offering group swim lessons to all members. Registration forms for swim lessons will be posted at the pool front desk during the opening weekend. Classes will **NOT START until after school is out for the summer**.

Payment by check will be required at the time of registration. Class space is limited and will be provided on a first come, first serve basis. Individual guards may also offer private lessons. For more information about lessons inquire at the front desk. Whether you're a returning family or new family, the registration process is simple and takes only a few minutes.

RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT WITH BROOKFIELD

On days when the Swim Team is hosting a home meet, the pool is closed to the general membership. There is a reciprocity agreement in place with Brookfield that allows our members to use their facility when our pool is closed for a swim meet. Please bring a photo ID with you to the Brookfield pool. Please note that this agreement is NOT in effect for July 15, 2019 as both pools are hosting home meets that evening.

DAILY GUESTS

Guest Passes: FIVE FOR FREE! All members are entitled to five free guest passes per year. Members must pick up their guest passes at the front desk. An adult must sign for the passes by name and member number.

Guest Pass Cost: An individual daily guest pass is \$5.00. The pool also offers a special discount pass that contains five (5) passes for \$20.00.

- Guest passes are good for the entire day. All guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. If
 you leave the pool, your guest(s) must leave with you; guests do not have in-and-out privileges.
- All guests must be checked in at the front desk with the sponsoring member present. Guests will not be sent through unless the member comes to the front desk to check them in.
- All guests must wear a wristband. The sponsoring member must also wear a corresponding wristband.
- Pool members age 13 or older may escort a guest(s) that is 13 years or older without an accompanying adult member, as long as he/she and the guest(s) are certified swim safe.
- Pool members age 13-15 years or older may escort a maximum of three (3) guests (age 13 years or older) at any one time.
- It is the Member's responsibility to ensure his/her guest(s) are aware of and follow all Pool rules.

GUEST PASS PAYMENT

The Pool accepts **CHECKS AND CREDIT CARDS ONLY – NO CASH**. This is standing Board policy, designed to protect the pool, and our guards, from potential theft. <u>Checks must be written on the member's bank account</u>, and cannot be accepted from non-members.

LONG –TERM GUESTS

Long-Term guest passes are available for people who are visiting and/or residing with you for an extended period of time. Nannies, au pairs and babysitters would also fit into this category. If you know you will be having a long term guest this summer, or if you need to add your nanny/au pair/babysitter, please contact the Administrative Assistant with your request.

- Each Long-Term Guest request is reviewed by the Board of Directors.
- Long-Term Guest passes must be renewed each year. They do not carry over from the previous year.
- The fee for a Long-Term Guest pass is \$75.00 for the entire season.
- Long-Term Guests are not permitted to use the Pool alone. They must always be with a member.
- Any Long-Term Guest who is 12 years old or younger must have an adult member present at all times.

2019 GUEST PASS RESTRICTIONS

Guest passes may **NOT** be used on the following dates. These popular holidays are reserved for members and renters only; no guests. Please plan accordingly.
